

CLASSIFICATION CIRCULAR 36

ADJUSTMENTS TO THE STANDARD CHART OF ACCOUNTS (SCOA)

- 1. The purpose of this circular is to inform government departments' financial practitioners of the changes made to the SCOA COR 5 in the second quarter of the 2021/22 financial year.
- Changes to the chart are discussed according to each segment of the chart. Reasons for amendments to the chart are provided along with an illustration of the impact thereof. Please refer to chart version 5 21.22.03 for detailed changes implemented.
- 3. Items shown in **red** indicate that they have been deleted/ removed; **blue** indicates that they have been changed/renamed, and **green** implies that a new item has been created/added in the chart.
- 4. Departments are requested to ensure that, where necessary, the PERSAL and BAS links are updated.

ITEM SEGMENT

COMPENSATION OF EMPLOYEES

9. A new item has been added for use by National Treasury only. This item is used to allocate contributions made by the department towards employees' pension and provident fund benefits while the employee is still in service of the Department. "The Department of Public Service and Administration ("DPSA") Circular 1 of 2012 provided SMS employees admitted to the Government Employees Pension Fund ("GEPF") a once-off choice to increase the pensionable salary component of the all-inclusive Total Cost to Company ("TCTC") remuneration package from 60% to 70% of TCTC with effect from 1 April 2012. The employer is liable for this additional liability in terms of Section 17(4) of the Government Employees Pension Law."

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RECEIPTS

13. A new item has been added under Sales of Capital assets for collection of money received from the sale of medical and allied equipment. Medical and allied equipment includes items such as diagnostic equipment (imaging: - ultrasound, MRI, CT scanners, x-ray), therapeutic equipment (infusion pumps, medical lasers, Lasik surgical machines), life support (ventilators, heart-lung, ECMO and dialysis), monitors (ECG, EEG, blood pressure and dissolved gases in the blood), diagnostic medical equipment (control of diabetes mellitus). Also included are wheelchairs, hospital beds, side tables, medicine trolleys and other medical furniture and equipment.
